

Traditional architecture and charming little corners

The Sequeros urban route is organised around a main route and two complementary tours.

The first one begins in Altozano square and leads to some of the most important places in the town, like the theatre, the Concejo tower, the church and Eloy Bullón square, places where the weight of History and the passing of time can be felt.

The other tours will take the visitor to emblematic places such as the Cabezuela viewpoint or El Robledo sanctuary.
